

Messages in Blackboard

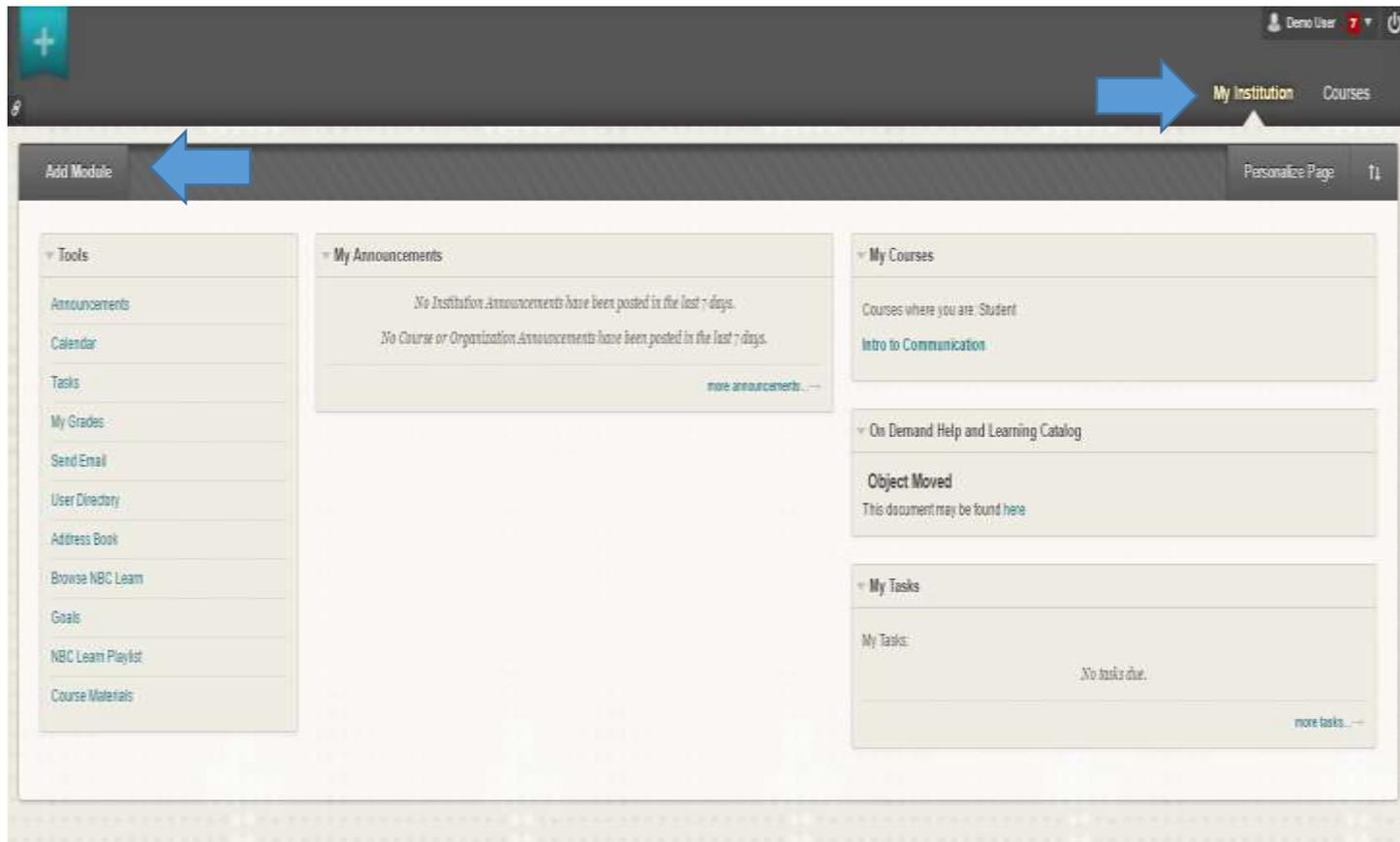
Question: Want to know when your instructor sends you a Message in a Blackboard course without needing to log into your course?

Answer: The solution is to add the Message Module.

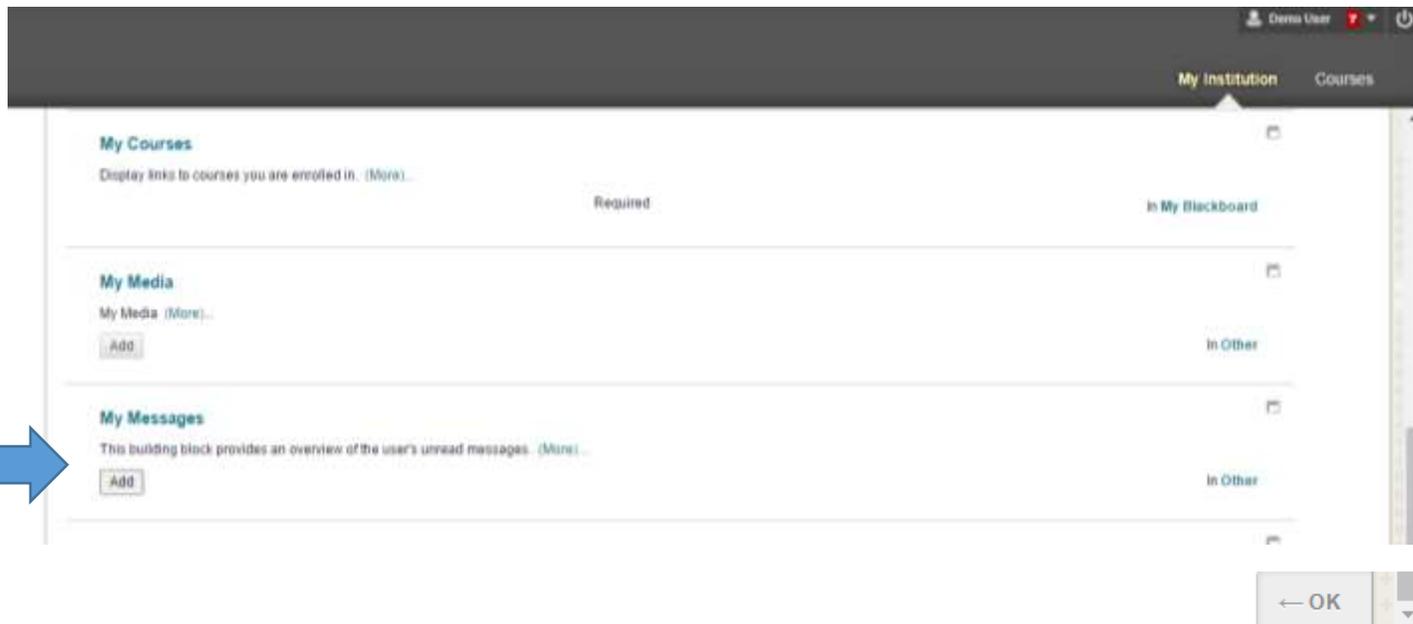
Here's how...

Once you log into your Blackboard account, go to your **My Institution** page in Blackboard.

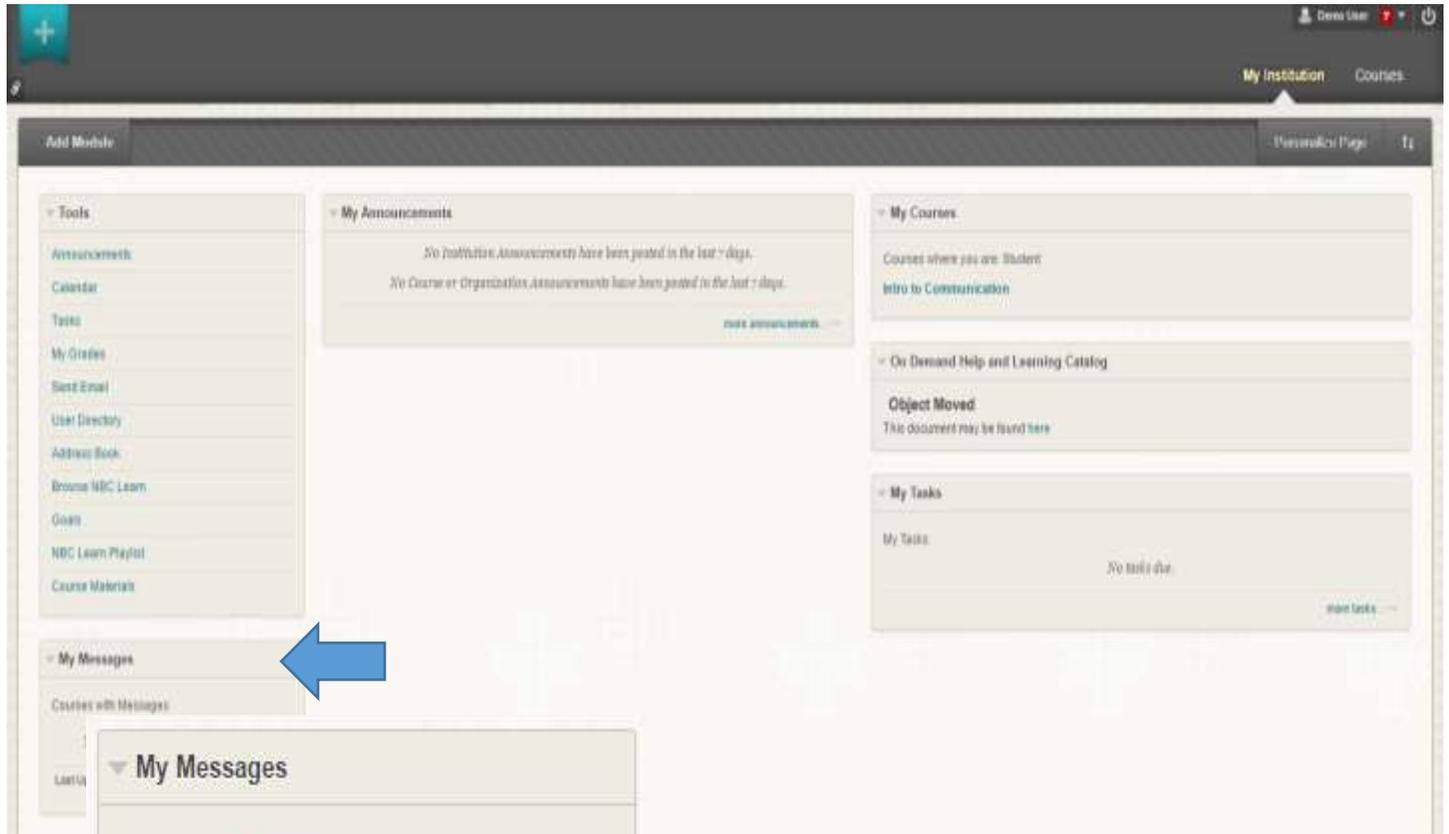
Then select **Add Module**



From the **Add Module window**, scroll down to **My Messages** and select **add**. Then scroll to the end of the page and select **OK**.



On your **My Institution** page, you should now see the **My Messages** module, which can be dragged to a new position on the page.

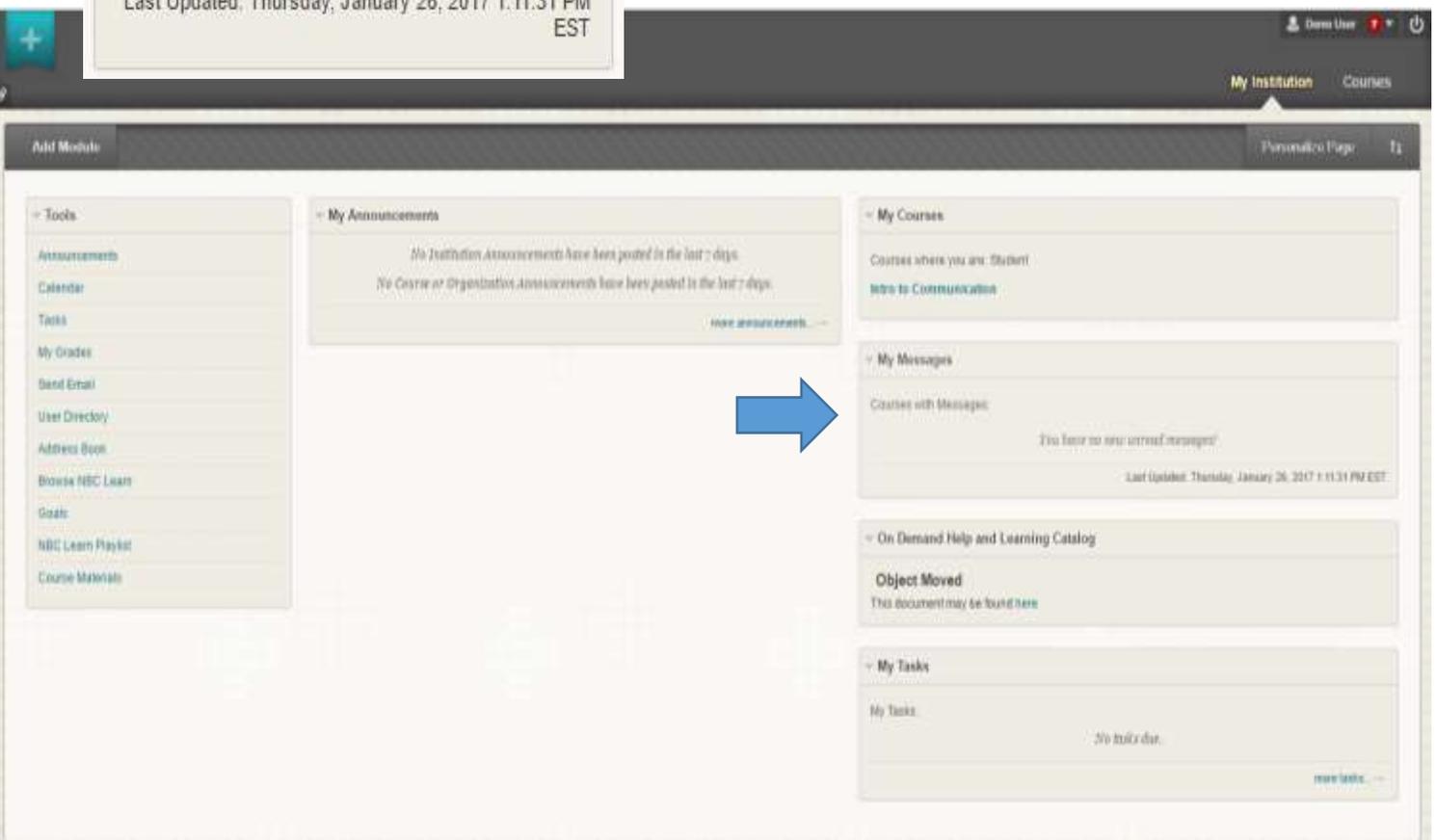

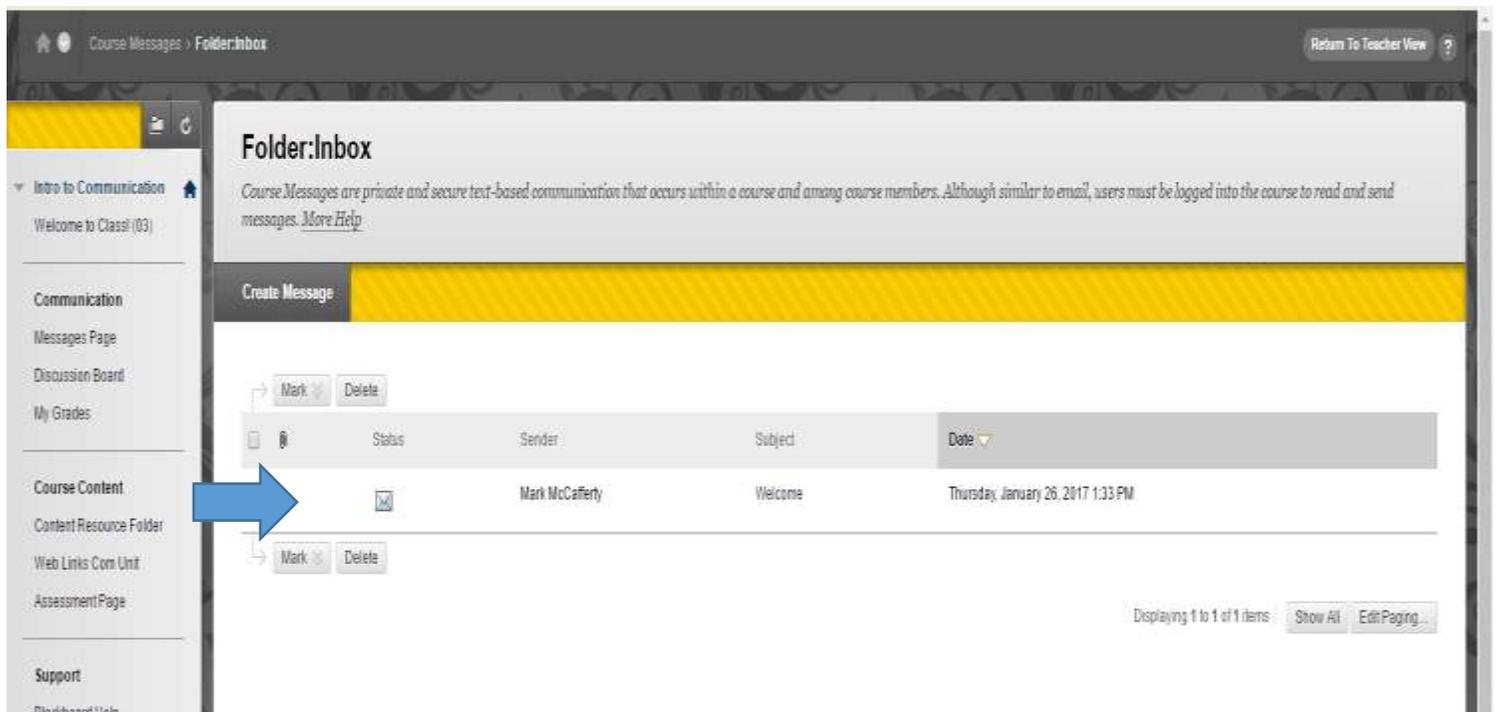
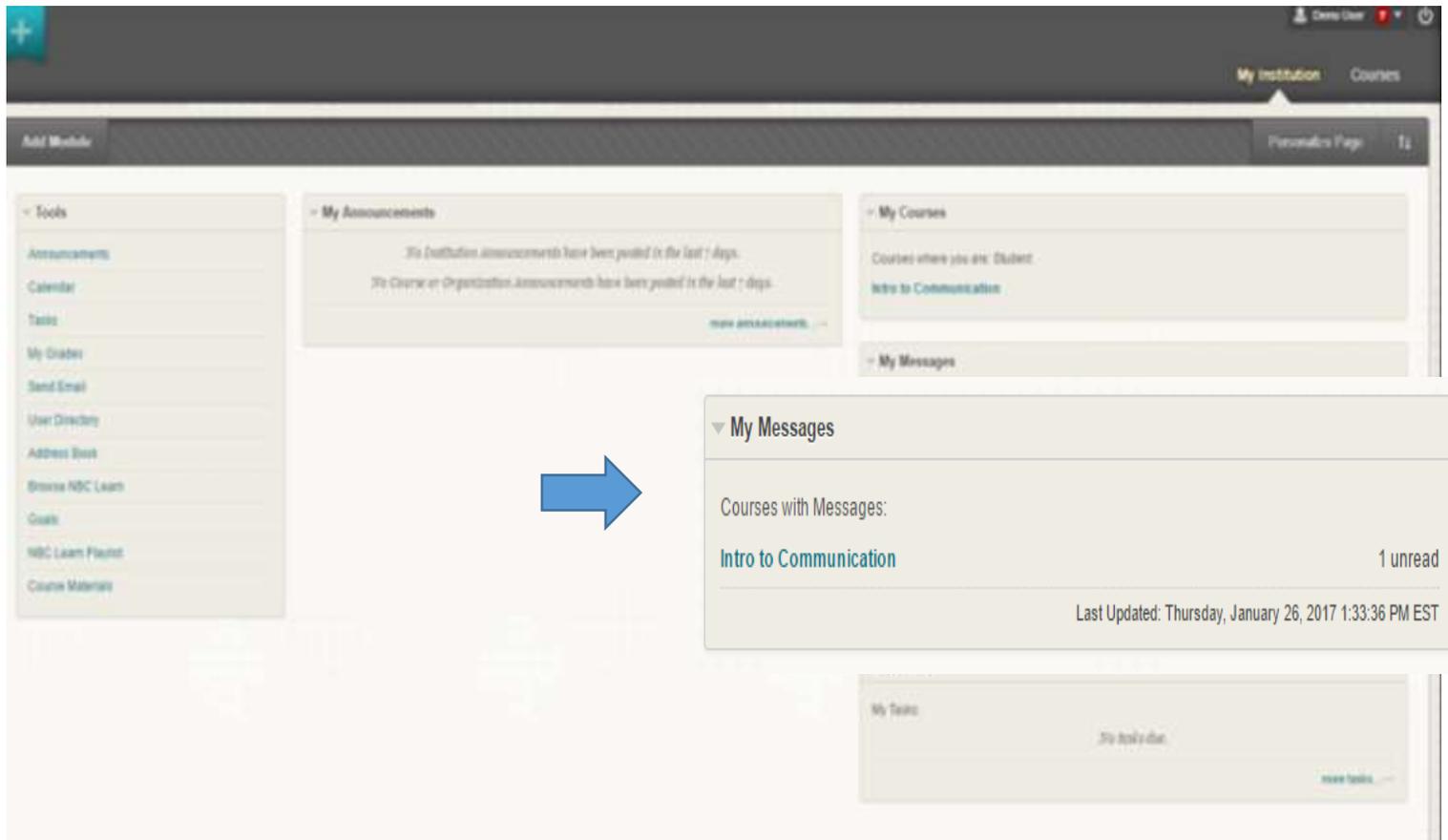
