

## **KVCC Course Evaluation**

Purpose: To give faculty the student's perception of whether course and learning goals were reached so faculty may improve the course and/or instruction of the course for future students.

- In 2013, the KVCC Course Evaluation Workgroup surveyed KVCC faculty members to establish the KVCC Course Evaluation Purpose and evaluation tool.
- The KVCC Course Evaluation is a standardized 11-core question tool intended to provide an opportunity for student participation in the course evaluation process.
  - The KVCC Course Evaluation tool was piloted during Summer 2013.
- For seated and hybrid classes, the KVCC Evaluation will be completed by paper and pencil/pen.
- Online classes will be given an electronic version of the survey.
- Departments and programs may add up to 5 individual questions for a course.
- Custom questions must be the same across all sections of a course.
- A Request for Custom Questions must be submitted to Melodie McCutcheon by the following:
  - October 15<sup>th</sup> ---Fall semester
  - February 15<sup>th</sup>—Spring semester
  - April 15<sup>th</sup>—Summer semester
- KVCC Course Evaluations will be distributed to Department Chairs three weeks prior to the conclusion of the academic term.
- It is recommended that the Course Evaluation Script is used to introduce the KVCC Course Evaluation to students.
  - Participation by students is voluntary.
